A physician-owned and directed medical organization increased Transitional Care Management (TCM) follow-up visits by 500% during the initial part of the COVID-19 pandemic.

A home health, palliative, and hospice organization earned over \$400,000 in revenue in just 5 months of using Pings to actively follow up with patients post-discharge.





More Select results from clients using Pings:



An ACO reduced the LOS for its managed patients from 25 days to 21 days, resulting in \$680,000 saved in their first year of using Pings.



An independent family practice improved their hospital follow-up rate in about a year of using Pings from 1.65% to 90%, and 26% to 80% for their ED follow-up rate.
