



Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in South Carolina With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in South Carolina can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund (SCORF) Board, <https://scorf.sc.gov/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share (Discretionary Sub fund Share):** The SCORF Board administers and disperses funds from the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund to applicants for approved abatement strategies.
2. **Local Share (Guaranteed Political Subdivision Sub fund Share):** Local county, city, and town officials approve funding applications submitted by localities and their approved entities. If the application is for approved abatement strategies, the SCORF Board must approve that application.
