



Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in South Dakota With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in South Dakota can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the South Dakota Department of Social Services (DSS), <https://dss.sd.gov/behavioralhealth/>.

Here's how:

- State Share:** Appropriated by the legislature for disbursement by DSS based on recommendations from the Opioid Advisory Committee, <https://doh.sd.gov/programs/lets-be-clear/prescription-opioid-abuse-prevention-initiative/>. DSS earmarks 25% of the total State Share for distribution via grants each SFY. SD based orgs can apply for SFY27 grants starting 11/3/25. The 2026 application period is closed. The minimum award amount is \$5,000, the maximum is \$35,000, <https://dss.sd.gov/behavioralhealth/grantinfo.aspx#:~:text=Opioid%20Settlement%20Fund%20Community%20Grant%20Program%22>.
- Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials but must be certified as proper use by the Opioid Advisory Committee. Counties must also consult their cities and towns.
