Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Wisconsin can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS), <https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/opioids/settlement-funds.htm>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** DHS submits an annual expenditure proposal to the Wisconsin state legislature's Joint Committee on Finance for approval. The Joint Committee can decide not to act (approving the proposal by default), decline to approve the proposal and schedule a meeting to discuss, or unilaterally change proposed expenditures and allocate funds accordingly.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials.
